I'm also delighted to announce that we hit the target for St James Gift Day! We were aiming for £15,000, and the current total is £15,064, with probably some more Gift Aid still to come. Several people also took the opportunity to set up new standing orders to St James. We are so grateful to everyone, and it is very humbling to see how much people are willing to invest in our church, so that we can continue to worship, pray, minister and reach out in the name of Jesus.

We also asked '*what St James means to me*', and here are 3 of the responses:

- * "A special place, set apart for the praise and worship of God; a special people, united in love and service; a special purpose, to know Jesus and to make Him known."
- * "I had an invitation to join a church service some years ago and I was made to feel so welcome that I wanted to stay. Since then I have served countless cups of tea and coffee, made some wonderful friends, shared a lot of problems, got confirmed to become part of the church, shared weekends away, put my foot into things lots of times, but it still feels like family."
- * "St James Church has been pivotal to my life...some of my dearest friendships have been among the fellowship here. Most importantly, it was here that I came to know Jesus. Although I had been brought up in a Christian family, it was not until I joined St James that I came to know Him as my friend and Saviour."

In other news:

- a new Centre Manager has been appointed at *St Peters Community Centre*, to start in September, we'll announce the name and do a proper 'hello and welcome' once various bits of paperwork have been sorted out. The Centre, and the St James Church Room, are starting to re-open to user groups, with additional precautions for coronavirus to keep everyone safe.

I mentioned on Sunday the*5 prayers for St James *that we started the year with, and how coronavirus has made them all much more difficult. But that's the point of praying for things, it's seeking God for the things that only He can do. So here are our 5 'Only God' prayers again for 2020, please do pray them with me:

Ø20 new or re-committed Christians in 2020

Ø20 people commissioned into new leadership roles (e.g. in cell groups, pastoral ministry, toddler, children and youth work, community chaplaincy)

Ø20:20 At least 20 under-20s part of the Sunday worshipping community every week.

Ø50:50 – 50% of St James' members under 50 by the year end, through growing among children, youth and younger adults.

Ø£20,000 surplus on the year to invest in mission
