- 1. Barnabas Fund** The main ministry of Barnabas Fund is to send financial support to Christians suffering discrimination, oppression and persecution for their faith. They support projects which strengthen Christian individuals, churches and their communities through spiritual and material support, in response to needs identified by local Christian leaders
- 2. Bible Society** In some parts of the world, the Scriptures are difficult to access or are simply unavailable. In this country, the Bible is readily available but has lost its significance and its value is unrecognised by millions. We're working hard here at home and in key areas across the world to change this.
- 3. Christian Aid** The official relief and development agency of 41 Christian churches in the UK and Ireland, and works to support sustainable development, eradicate poverty, support civil society and provide disaster relief in South America, the Caribbean, Africa and Asia.
- 4. Compassion UK** Releasing children from poverty in Jesus' name. Working in partnership with local churches in developing countries, we link a child in critical need with a caring sponsor. Each sponsor enables us to provide exceptional care for their sponsored child through every stage of their childhood.
- 5. Counselling4Yeovil** A Christian organisation offering affordable professional counselling in Yeovil to people of any or no faith.
- 6. Great Lakes Outreach Burundi** This is a mission for Burundi a land locked African country, war torn and one of the poorest countries in the world.
- 7. Open Doors** Open Doors works in over 60 countries, supplying Bibles, training church leaders, providing practical support and emergency relief, and supporting Christians who suffer for their faith. In the UK and Ireland, Open Doors works to raise awareness of global persecution, mobilising prayer, support and action among Christians.
