Sunday morning will be an all-age service, so there'll be plenty for our children/grandchildren to engage with in the service, as well as everyone else! Please do support these, when our children were younger we really appreciated the older church members who took time to speak to our children, and it made a lasting impression on them, We'd like to say a big *thankyou to Naomi McKnight, *who is stepping down from running the Tuesday morning Tots and Toys. She has put in lots of work not just in setting it up every week, but in getting to know the mums and families who come along, and supporting them through what has been a very tough season for everyone.
